# **Lackawanna College Academic Achievement Scholarship Program**

Lackawanna College will award the Academic Achievement scholarship to students entering the College in the Fall semester. Scholarship awards are \$1,000 per academic year.

## **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

- Eligibility for this award is based on combined SAT score or composite ACT score:
  - 1100 or more on the Evidence Based Reading & Writing and Math sections on the SAT, or
  - 22 or more composite score on the ACT
- Only applicants with SAT or ACT scores obtained within three (3) years prior to the student's first semester at Lackawanna College will be considered eligible for this scholarship.
- Applicants must be full-time, degree seeking students to be considered eligible for this scholarship.

## **SCHOLARSHIP RESTRICTIONS**

- The amount of the scholarship may be limited to the amount of tuition, fees, and books not covered by grant aid or other scholarship funds. Students receiving scholarships must apply for all grant aid for which they may be eligible.
- The College will not make direct cash payments to the scholarship recipients.
- Scholarship recipients must maintain a cumulative quality point index (CQPI) of 3.25 to remain eligible for this award. Academic progress will be reviewed annually.
- Scholarship recipients must remain in continuous, full-time, degree-seeking study at Lackawanna College to remain eligible for this award.

## **APPLICATION GUIDELINES**

To be considered for this scholarship program, students must submit this application, a copy of their official high school transcript including SAT or ACT scores, and recommendation from a guidance counselor or teacher who can attest to their scholarship. Applications may be obtained from guidance counselors or Lackawanna College.
