

JANE MacKENZIE SCHOLARSHIP

Description

The Jane MacKenzie Scholarship is an annual scholarship awarded in honor of Jane MacKenzie, an alumna of Lackawanna Business College and benefactor of Lackawanna College. Jane also spent many years serving as the business manager of the Century Club, which established this scholarship in her memory. This scholarship is designed to promote Business Education, assist the selected student with college expenses, and encourage high academic achievement.

Criteria

Scholarship is awarded annually to an incoming freshman from the Scranton School District. Preference for this award will be given to students planning to enroll in one of the college's Business Programs. Candidates for this financial award should be seeking full-time enrollment and must show strong academic ability.

Award

The amount of the award is full tuition after financial aid (grants only) has been applied to the student's account. The funding is limited to tuition assistance and includes \$450 per semester for books and supplies. This is a two year scholarship as long as the student maintains established academic criteria.

Application Procedure

Student must submit the application to the Lackawanna College Admissions Office along with required materials by the application deadline. Selected students will be notified shortly after the deadline.

Deadline

Application deadline for this scholarship is **April 30th**.

- Must be an incoming freshman student from the Scranton School District
- Preference will be given to students applying to the college's Business Program.
- Two hundred word essay on the importance of receiving this scholarship.
- Submit a copy of official high school transcripts and SAT/ACT SCORES.
- Student must maintain full-time enrollment status to be eligible.
- Student must complete 24 credits with a 2.5 GPA during first academic year to be eligible for second year.
- **Scholarship Application Deadline is April 30th.**
